panying samples.

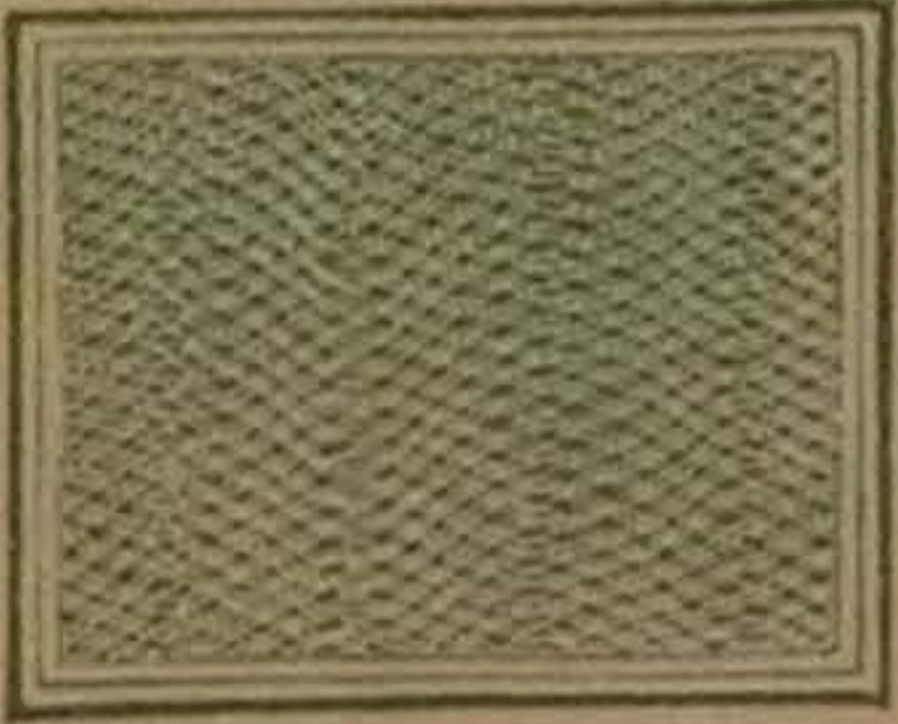
