La última edición de estampillas hecha por esa compañía para esta Dirección, se diferencia de las anteriores por el mayor tamaño de casi todos los tipos, con excepción del de cuatro centavos, cuyas pequeñas dimensiones permiten que el timbrado de inutilización caiga de lleno sobre todo el signo. No pasa lo mismo con las otras formas, por su gran tamaño. El sello, muchas veces, no alcanza á llenar la estampilla; la inutiliza por un extremo tan sólo, y, así, permite que los defraudadores se sirvan de ella para lavarla y utilizarla nuevamente.

Con vista de esto, he de estimar de la Compañía se sirva manifestarme si todos los actuales tipos de emisión podrían reducir su formato, adoptando por tamaño el de la estampilla de cuatro centavos, en actual circulación.

Aprovecho la oportunidad para rogar á U. se moleste en decirme si la Compañía conserva en sus muestrarios estampillas peruanas de todas las emisiones que ella ha tenido á su cargo, y, si las tiene, si podría proporcionar á esta Dirección dos ejemplares de cada una de ellas.

Sir,-

The last edition of stamps made by your Co. for this Dept. are different from the previous ones because of the larger size of almost all the values, with the exception of that of 4 centavos; whose small dimensions make it impossible to take in all of the canceling stamp. The same does not accord with the other forms because of their great size. The canceling stamp many times fails to cover the postage stamp; it cancels it so extremely small, and thus permits the defrauders to use it by washing it and utilizing it anew. In view of this, I will thank your Co. to be pleased to advise me if all the present values of emission could be reduced in form, adopting for the size that of the stamp of 4 centavos in present circulation.

I avail of the opportunity to ask you to trouble yourself to tell me whether the Co. preserves among its specimen Peruvian stamps, all of the emissions which it has had under its charge; and if it has them, whether it could supply to this Dept. two copies of each one of them.

We have the honor to acknowledge your valued favor
 of November 5th. In answer we beg to say that after refer-
 ring to your letter of September 6th, 1906, in which you
 placed with us the order for the new issue of stamps to which
 you have reference in your letter of November 5th of this
 year, we find that we executed the order for this new edition
 exactly in accordance with your directions and samples in-
 closed in your letter of September 6th, 1906, the time the or-
 der was placed.

In regard to your request as to the present issue of
 stamps now in circulation, whether same could be arranged so
 as to have a uniform size similar to that of the 4 Centavos,
 we regret to say that this would mean the re-engraving of new
 plates of all the larger denominations to bring them down to
 the size of the 4 Centavos stamps.

If you have been induced to make this change because
 the cancelling stamp is not large enough to cover the larger

stamps, why would it not be advisable to have a larger cancel-
 ling stamp made? This is only a suggestion on our part, in
 case you should find it practicable.

We are glad to report to you that we always preserve
 in our vaults the plates of all issues of stamps printed for
 Governments, unless we receive specific instructions to have
 the same destroyed, and in case of the Government of Peru we
 are pleased to say that all the plates are in hand, and in ac-
 cordance with your request we beg to inclose you herewith two
 envelopes containing each 40 stamps, duly cancelled, which
 will give you a double set of all the specimens of stamps that
 we have furnished your Honorable Government.
