We have recently received an inquiry from a large commission house here in New York, asking if we can furnish postage stamp making machinery for Peru.

Of course, as you fully realize the making of machinery and selling same is not part of our business. We have, however, been careful to reply diplomatically to their inquiry.

In the meantime, it seems to us that we should advise you of this circumstance as it quite possibly may be an indication that the Government of Peru is considering establishing a printing plant of its own for the making of their postage stamps, etc.

We would be very much obliged to you if you would investigate this matter in your own way and give us such information as you can obtain on the subject.

Dear Sirs:-

Replying to your favor of March 20th, inquiring about machinery for making postage stamps, and with reference to the conversation the writer had with you on the 22nd inst., we have gone into this matter but do not find that there is any such thing that would give the results that would be required.

There are all kinds of automatic presses which perform various operations but none that would turn out a document that would be good enough in any way for use as a postage stamp. Moreover, these automatic presses print only from type and, therefore, offer practically no security for a document of any value. To obtain proper security postage stamps should be printed from steel, in the same manner as most governments throughout the world have theirs printed for them.

It seems to us that your request probably comes from some one who has no technical knowledge or who knows nothing of the printing business.

Before any intelligent action or even investigation could be taken in this matter it would be necessary to know exactly what results your customer wishes to obtain, whether he wishes to print from steel plates or by lithography; the size of the stamps desired; whether they are to be printed in one or two colors; whether the press is to be used for printing various kinds of stamps of different sizes, etc. All of these details would have to be known before the style and size of press could be decided upon.
